With reference to your online application dated $11 / 06 / 2014$, I am directed to inform you that the Board has considered the undertaking certified by the Management and the Principal of the School on the confirmation page and has decided to grant provisional affiliation to the above said school for Senior Secondary School Cextificate Examination for a period of three years w.e.f. 01.04 .2015 to 31.03 .2018 without inspection, in the following subjects:-
(a) Languages:- Hindi Core, Hindi Elective, English Core, English Elective.
(b) Elective Subjects: Accountancy, Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, Entrepreneurship, Mathematics, Physical Education \& Physics.

Since the Upgradation has been granted without inspection as per Circular No. 6 issued on 22/01/2013, the school is likely to be inspected at any time in future to confirm its suitability including labs, teaching staff and other requirement required for Senior Secondary Level School.

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7. The school will provide well equipped Library with all relevant reference books to the academic level of students and would keep at least 05 books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.
8. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
9. As per Affiliation Bye-laws the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than 40 students.
10. School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers and would ensure computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. Proper software along with facility of Broad Band connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider to be ensured.
